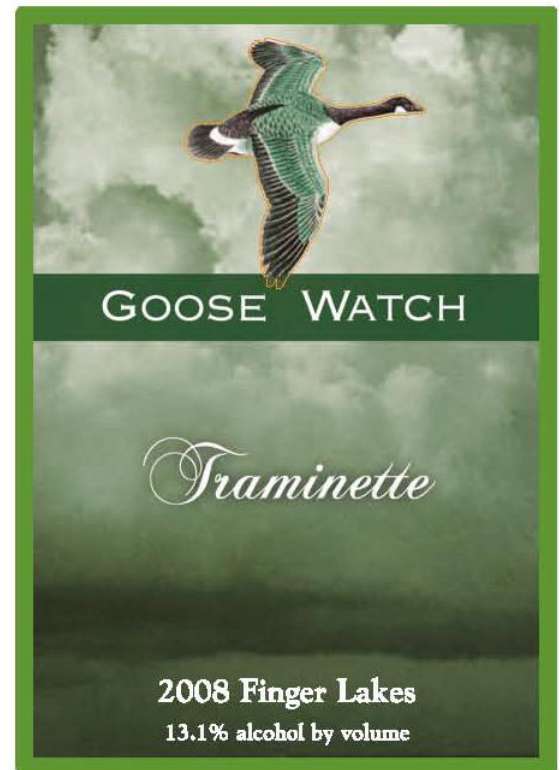

Winemaker's Notes: Year in and year out, this Cornell developed varietal shows why it is carving out an important place in the Finger Lakes wine industry. With its spicy aromas that are reminiscent of Gewürztraminer (its parent variety), Traminette adds a fruity almost tropical like flavors to add to the complexity, This is an outstanding vintage that has already won 4 gold medals! While most other local wineries make this wine sweeter, we are sticking to this wonderfully smooth and complex dry style.

Food Suggestions: The crisp fruit flavors and spicy finish make this wine a great accompaniment to many oriental dishes.
